Dear Students!

Below you will find basic information about the formal rules of study, which we hope will make it easier to start studying in our Institute:

1. STUDENT IDENTITY CARD

In the case of a rejected photo in IRK (Online Recruitment of Students), the ID card printing will not be issued, please update the photo in IRK.

Those who have an ID card can continue to use it (a student can use only one Warsaw University ID card). If the card was previously issued by another department, it should be collected from there. If a person has previously studied at the University of Warsaw, and wants a new card, it is necessary to cancel the "old" card by the department that issued it.

2. TIMETABLE

Current class schedules are always available on the website. Plans in USOSweb may not be updated on a regular basis.

3. USOSweb ACCOUNT

Each student is assigned an individual USOSweb account, to which you can log in with a login and password.

4. UNIVERSITY MAIL SERVICES

It is mandatory to use the university email address for student affairs. Those who previously had an account at the University of Warsaw continue to use it for graduate studies.

5. DORMITORIES AND SOCIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who wish to receive a place in a student house, or a social/special scholarship, will be required to fill out an application in the USOSweb system.

6. SPECIALIZATIONS

- 1st year students follow a joint program during the first two semesters of studies.
- in the middle of the second semester, students submit a written declaration regarding the choice of specialty from the second year of studies:
-

1) Design Thinking in Law – a specialty focusing on the education of personnel dealing with research on the creation and shaping of law in the linguistic context, its conceptualization, terminology, textemics and logic;

2) Transference of Legal Knowledge – a specialty focusing on the training of staff involved in research on the social perception of legal information, in particular the simplification of this information and its anthropological and ethnographic aspects;

3) Epistemology of Lawyering – a specialty focusing on the education of personnel dealing with research on communication effectiveness in the field of advocacy.

7. TUITION FEES

- one-off payment: 13200 zł (due by 5 October),
- in 2 instalments: 13600 zł (I instalment: 6800 zł, due by 5 October, II instalment: 6800 zł, due by 5 March).
